ORANGEVILLE PUBLIC LIBRARY RECEIVES \$15,000 GRANT TOWARDS CHILDREN’S ROOM ADDITION

Orangeville, PA – The Orangeville Public Library (Pennsylvania) has received a \$15,000 grant from Central Susquehanna Community Foundation’s Berwick Health and Wellness Fund to support its children’s room addition project.

“We are excited for the opportunity to construct a new children’s room in our library,” explains Pam Simpson, librarian. “This expansion will enable the Library to better serve our youngest patrons through larger and more varied children’s programs, and will create needed room to increase our collections of children’s books and STEM supplies.”

The Orangeville Public Library is a free public library founded in 1927 to serve the educational and recreational needs of its local community. The library does not charge a membership fee to anyone, regardless of where they live, for general library services as well as public computers and internet access, and programs for adults and children.

“We are grateful for partnerships with individuals and organizations like Central Susquehanna Community Foundation that allow us to continue to grow as an asset to our community and surrounding area. We look forward to the new opportunities this expansion project will bring,” says Simpson.
